

your current requirements, and adapt to changes in your personal circumstances should they occur in the future. We can also provide priority access to our rest home or care facility should that ever become necessary.


Our friendly staff will do everything they can to make you feel at home, engaged and part of things here at Bainswood House.

Bainswood on Victoria has 57 beds which are a mix of rest home and hospital style rooms. We have a range of room options available, from partially to fully ensuited.

Villas and serviced apartments

Bainswood House retirement community has four independent villas and 15 serviced apartments, three of which are doubles. Serviced apartments consist of a living area with kitchenette and fully ensuited bedrooms. Apartment sizes vary and some homes are designed specifically for couples.

Rest home

Our 26 bed rest home has a range of room options available and includes partial ensuite and full ensuite. You're welcome to add your own personal touches and display your treasured ornaments to help make your room feel like home.

The community has a warm ambient atmosphere with a large modern dining room, library, hairdresser, resident in-house podiatrist, music, sky television and phone.

We prepare delicious and nutritious home-cooked meals and baking on-site daily, and these are served In our spacious dining room. Special dietary needs are catered for.

There is 24 hour fire security and a modern call bell system.

Professional services are provided by local medical practitioners, as well as our own trained staff.

Bainlea House

Bainlea House is our specialist 27 bed dementia care facility and caters for both respite care and long term care. The staff at Bainlea are highly experienced and focussed on this specialist field of care, and are on duty around the clock to ensure residents receive constant attention

Can I move into the care facilities of the community later on?

Yes, as part of our community, you will have priority access to the care services offered by other facilities within Arvida. If you might need a little extra help in the future with your day-to-day living, you can choose to move within our group of communities to more suitable accommodation.

What happens if I'm ill while living in my serviced apartment?

A staff member will respond to your call and arrange assistance where needed.

Can my family and friends stay with me in my home?

Yes of course, you can have family and friends come to stay in your apartment any time while they are visiting. There is also parking available for visitors.

Can I have my pets with me?

Yes, we know that pets are important and are often a much loved part of the family. Our manager will need to confirm that your pet is suitable for our community.

Is there space for my car?

There is parking provided in the car park area – please ask our village manager for more info.

Is there security at night?

Our community is fully fenced. Our staff are also on site 24 hours a day, should you need them. There are also emergency call buttons in all of the apartments throughout Bainswood House.

What other costs will I have?

In addition to the Deferred Management Fee, you will be responsible for:

- Your telephone bill
- Your contents insurance
- Sky TV
- Doctors visits, pharmacy & podiatry



There is a weekly village fee and there may also be costs for any extra services should you require them. See serviced apartment brochure for details and current prices.

Can I arrange for any other fittings to be added to my home?

At Bainswood House, we do everything we can to ensure you have your home the way you want it. You can choose to add items to make life a little easier like a security door or fly screens. We can help you with these extras but they will be at your cost.

Who pays for maintenance?

Bainswood House takes care of all exterior maintenance of your home, gardens and communal facilities.

What happens when I leave?

We do our best to support you and your family in every way we can over this difficult time. The village fees stop immediately after you leave, and we begin the marketing and sale of your ORA.
