PLEASE BRING FOR YOUR STAY

- Toothpaste, shampoo, body wash and other personal care items for individual use
- Clothing very important if your family member is coming from hospitalplease name your clothing
- ✓ Personal continence products & dressings for any existing wounds
- All medication, labelled & sealed in blister packs. We also require a medication chart signed by a doctor for our staff to follow.
- ✓ If you are coming from hospital, the hospital needs to send the most updated script to
 your usual pharmacy on discharge day. You will then need to pick the meds up from t
 as the pharmacies do not usually deliver. Please bring the script with you for our
 nurse.
- Any mobility equipment that maybe required e.g., walker or wheelchair
- We request that you arrive <u>10-11am</u> on the morning of your stay.
 This timing works best to allocate a registered nurse for your admission.
 On the day your stay ends, departure is by 12:00pm.





FULL BOARDING & LODGINGS

- Cleaning services and supplies;
- All residents are responsible for bringing personal toiletry items with them for during their stay;
- All bedding, a bedside cabinet, and wardrobe;
- All meals, including morning/afternoon tea & supper;
- Activities programme
- Implementation of a short term care plan as agreed with the resident, primary carer, or family





PERSONAL HYGIENE FACILITIES

- Showering and bathing facility;
- ✓ Care with and assessment of skin, nails and oral hygiene.



PERSONAL GROOMING

- Assistance with dressing as required;
- Assistance with preferred hair style;
- Assistance with accessories and make-up.
- ✓ Items used in programmes are supplied. Activities Programmes are also incorporated in your individualised Care Plan.



SERVICES NOT INCLUDED IN THE FEE

- Prescription charges and any charges for or in respect of any medication
- Ambulance charges & transportation to & from outpatient services or appointments
- > Specialised assessment
- Specialist treatment
- Rehabilitation services
- Customised equipment, personal care equipment & personal mobility equipment (although some financial assistance may be available from other agencies e.g. ACC/ISS)
- Hairdressing, beautician, podiatrist services
- Laundry & dry cleaning
- Replacement & repairs to spectacles, dentures, hearing aids or other prosthesis
- Private telephone rental & calls (we do have a shared residents mobile phone)
- ► Insurance for resident's belongings
- ★ Superior room charges
- Properties Optical, audiology, dental and/or dietetic services
