Harper Gardens Apartments

Harper Gardens at Fitzgerald has modern spacious one and two bedroom apartments. Each has a full kitchen and ensuite bathroom with under-floor heating throughout.

Harper Gardens has a large sunny lounge on the first floor available to the residents for social activities. Communal laundry facilities are easily accessible on the ground floor. A lift or stairs provide access to all first floor apartments.

Harper Gardens has an active social group with monthly happy hours and movie sessions. Residents can also participate in the gardening club or join in with regular walks.



All apartments are fitted with sprinklers and smoke detectors. There are nightly security patrols of the entire complex.

Each apartment has a call bell system monitored 24/7. There is a Registered Nurse available at all times if needed.

Residents purchase an Occupation Right Agreement and there is a weekly service charge.

Holdsworth House Rest Home

Our Rest Home rooms are located in Holdsworth House. They offer a choice between standard single bedrooms or premium bed sitting rooms which have an ensuite and tea/coffee making facilities (premium fees payable).

There are inviting lounges and an informal, relaxed dining room. 24-hour care is provided to meet your needs. There is a registered nurse available onsite 24/7.



Hiron-Trinity Secure Rest Home

A separate wing of Fitzgerald House, Hiron-Trinity Wing is a secure rest home unit with single rooms, providing care for mentally frail residents. There is a registered nurse available onsite 24/7.

A relaxed environment allows individuals the opportunity to make choices and contribute to decisions which affect them.

Fitzgerald Hospital



Fitzgerald Hospital offers mostly single rooms overlooking tended gardens, and two double rooms. There is a registered nurse available onsite 24/7.

There is a large, airy central lounge and dining room as well as other smaller sitting areas around the hospital.

Rest Home and Hospital Care

On admission a care plan is developed for each new resident to ensure appropriate continuity of support and treatment. Every resident and their family or whānau have the opportunity to participate in this process. This service is included in the fees.

Physical, emotional, mental and spiritual needs are covered in the activities programme. Family are invited to join in with the activities during visits.

Residents are welcome to bring personal items of furniture, a television, radio, armchair, etc, to make their room their home.
